What is a "Green Lab"?

Volunteers (of legal age) self-administer cannabis under the observation of instructors. Students administer sobriety tests on these volunteers to determine if they are impaired. After consumption, dose amounts, administration methods, and impairment indicators are documented and reviewed.

Who benefits?

Everyone who is involved in this training benefits. With legalization, law enforcement officers will contact more drivers who have used a cannabis product. This training will help officers distinguish between someone who has used a cannabis product medicinally (low doses and is not impaired) versus someone who has over-consumed.

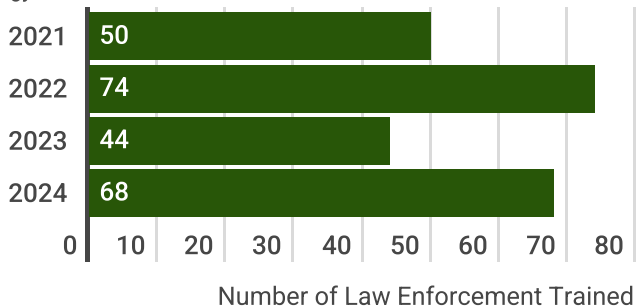
Volunteer consumers also benefit. After speaking with our volunteers, they were excited to see how field sobriety tests worked. They were also surprised officers did not automatically consider them impaired just because they had consumed. At low doses, officers considered the volunteers not impaired in approximately 93% of cases.

The local community also benefits from this training. Communities want to see responsible use while their rights are preserved and respected. This training brings cannabis consumers and law enforcement officers together, helping them better understand each other while building relationships.

Hosting Agencies

Any entity may request to host the training at their facility:

Provide a classroom and a space large enough to conduct test administration. **Typically, this will need to be the size of a gymnasium. **

Important Resources

Officer Training

This course has been approved for law enforcement continuing educations hours (6 hours of Technical Studies). Each Missouri officer who attends will be awarded mandatory training hours. Extract-ED submits these hours to the state and maintains all necessary records.

Classroom

Due to its size, and to have space for the Lab portion, this course demands a large training room. Typically, this involves renting 1-2 salon rooms from a local conference center. (Typically the size of a gymnasium)

Instructors

Each volunteer consumer must have an instructor with them at all times. These instructors assist the volunteers with anything they may need and record information during the Green Lab. Each instructor monitors the students as they administer field sobriety tests. These instructors are considered experts in their field and help ensure the training's integrity and results. In addition to paying their expenses, these instructors travel from around the state and often require overnight lodging.

Registered Nurse

A registered nurse will be on-site during consumption and throughout the Green Lab. This ensures volunteer patient consumers are observed by a medical professional who can assist them with questions or any complications at all times.

Volunteer Transportation/Consumption Location (if needed)

Volunteer consumers will be transported by Extract-ED instructors to the classroom from the consumption site. This involves renting several vehicles large enough to fit all volunteers. Once the training has concluded, all volunteers will be provided a ride home if needed.
